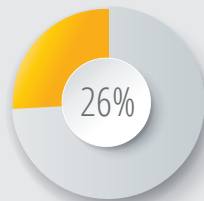


Adult Smokers in Lucas County

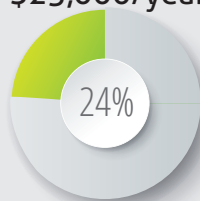
Smoking rates among Lucas County adults continues to decline, but there is still concern with certain groups.

Groups of Highest Concern

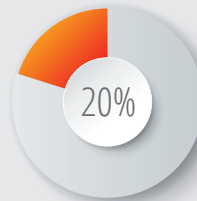
Latinos



Income less than \$25,000/year

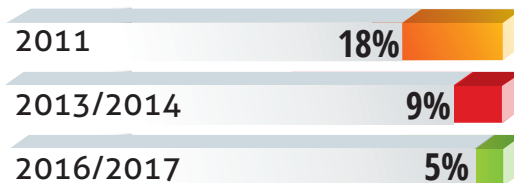


Ages 30-64
